

Credit-review preparation

A thin file, no known history and a missing credit score are different descriptions. None means that an application involves no credit review. Prepare the questions below before deciding whether to submit information.

What you know about the credit file or missing score

What inquiry or information review is described?

At which stage does that review occur, and who performs it?

Required documents and date range (confirm with actual request)

What is stated about post-funding payment reporting?

Questions still unanswered before proceeding
